What is Digital Theatre+?


- Founded in 2009






How do I access DT+?

To sign into your DT+ account for the first time, you can create a username and password by selecting the 'sign-in now' button in your welcome email.

How to set-up school wide access

To set-up access for your students and other teaching staff, you'll need to decide which of our available authentication options works best for you.

It's always a good idea to ask your IT department to help you with this.

What we recommend:

- <u>Single Sign On with SAML 2 (SSO)</u> Uses your existing sign-in credentials
- <u>Email Address</u> One per user, must be updated for joiners or leavers

Setting up your school-wide access...

We strongly recommend the use of Single Sign-On (SSO) with SAML to authenticate your users to the Digital Theatre+ service.

- Safety and security of user data
- Improved user experience
- Use your existing sign-in method




Adult Content Filters
